SUBMISSION DEADLINE

Absolute deadline for applications is **February 28, 2024 NO EXCEPTIONS**.

All applications must be **IN THE STATE FMBA OFFICE** by **4 pm** on the **FEBRUARY 28, 2024 DEADLINE** this applies to electronic submissions as well.

Applications must be typewritten or computer generated and either e-mailed or mailed to NJ FMBA office.

DO NOT STAPLE OR FOLD ANY APPLICATION MATERIAL

PLEASE MAKE SURE YOUR APPLICATION IS COMPLETE AND THAT ALL ATTACHMENTS ARE INCLUDED IN THE PACKAGE.

Recommendations <u>MUST</u> be sent <u>WITH</u> the application, <u>NOT</u> Separately. If school will not give student the recommendations, student should request school submits entire applications and attachments on student's behalf.

All applications will be opened on or about March 1st and under no circumstances will an applicant be notified of any packet disqualification.

Winners will be notified by mail and published in the NJ FMBA Bulletin.

No other notifications will be sent out.

GUIDELINES, REQUIREMENTS, AND JUDGING CRITERIA

SCHOLARSHIP AWARDS

Four scholarships will be awarded. Each award will be for \$1,500 per year, up to a \$6,000 scholarship, payable directly to the institution of higher education being attended by the recipient. This will be renewed as long as the recipient maintains a scholastic average satisfactory to the institution he/she is attending. Recipients must be accepted by an accredited institution of higher learning (college, university, career or vocational school). The scholarship award will be continued for a recipient attending a two-year college who transfers to an accredited four-year college or university. Maximum award is \$6,000.

ELIGIBILITY

Applications will be limited to:

- High school seniors who are the children or grandchildren of Active NJ FMBA members
- High school seniors who are the children or grandchildren of Local 500 NJ FMBA members
- High school seniors who are the children of deceased active or retired NJ FMBA members who were members at the time of their death

REQUIREMENTS BEYOND PHYSICAL APPLICATION AND ESSAY

- Each application MUST BE SIGNED by either the President or Executive Delegate of the Local FMBA
 to certify eligibility, Local 500 applications will be verified and signed once submitted. Signatures from
 the Local from which a member is retired is not eligible. NJ FMBA members will be required to maintain
 NJ FMBA membership for duration of scholarship. Retired members will be required to maintain
 membership in Local 500 for duration of scholarship.
- Diploma Requirements: The applicant must be a bona fide student of a private, parochial or public school eligible to receive a high school diploma at the completion of the senior year prior to September 1 of the year of enrollment in an institution of higher learning.
- Aspirations: The student must have a definite plan to pursue a post-high school program of education or training on a full time basis.
- Character: The applicant must exhibit good citizenship traits and be of sound moral character.
- Applicant must arrange for and obtain the two letters of recommendation. These recommendations
 must be included in the application paperwork submitted by the applicant to the NJ FMBA by the
 February 28th deadline. NO EXCEPTIONS.

SELECTION CRITERIA

Applicants will be judged on nine (9) criteria, using a point system, with the maximum obtainable score being 50 points. The criteria are:
